Crisis in Europe – no End in Sight?

Dr. Jörg Krämer, Chief Economist, Commerzbank

The UK voted to leave the EU. Anti EU parties are also on the rise in other European countries. What is the future of the EU and the currency union in particular? Will the ECB gloss over the unsolved problems of the currency union by an ever looser monetary policy? And what are the implications of such a policy?

Putting Europe in a broader perspective, Dr. Jörg Krämer, also shares his perspective on the Asian economies and explains Commerzbank's outlook for global bond yields and currencies.
